This unit is a self-evaluation of your way of engaging students in your online and offline classes.

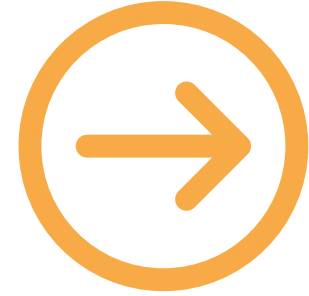
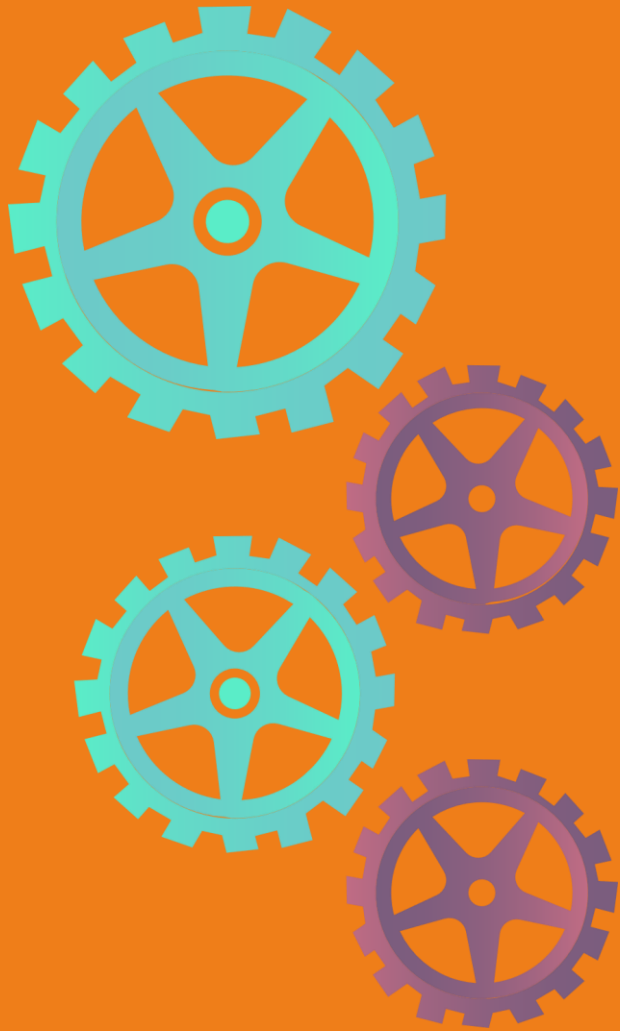
*Now is time to reflect/evaluate what **works for you** within online environment (what courses or meetings did you experience and what was beneficial and what did not work).*
